TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR USE, MODIFICATION, AND DISTRIBUTION

1. Definitions

“License”

the terms and conditions for use, modification, and distribution as defined by Sections 1 through 9 of this License.

“Licensor”

the copyright owner or entity authorized by the copyright owner that is granting the License.

“Legal Entity”

an organization, whether or not incorporated, of the acting entity and all other entities that are controlled by, or are under the control of, that entity.
