PSC03 – Notice of Other Registrable Person with Significant Control

Companies House Form PSC03 Notice of Other Registrable Person (ORP) with Significant Control, should be used to give notice of an other registrable person (ORP) with significant control.

As of 26th June 2017, companies must enter new information on their register to Companies House within 14 days of becoming aware of a change. This information is no longer provided annually to Companies House. Companies must enter new information on their register to Companies House within 14 days, once they have:

- become aware of a change
- obtained all the information
- confirmed the information

Information on a company's register must be kept up to date.
