	Ensure PPE is not a cause of overheating.
	Ensure access to cold fresh water.

<i>Probability (P)</i>	<i>5=very likely, 4=likely, 3=quite possible, 2=possible, 1=unlikely</i>
<i>Severity (S)</i>	<i>5=fatal, 4=severe, 3=moderate, 2=slight, 1=negligible</i>
<i>Risk (R)</i>	<i>0-8=low risk, no action required. 9-15=medium risk, ensure ad</i>

<i>&gt;25=high risk, stop operation &amp; implement control measures</i>
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
